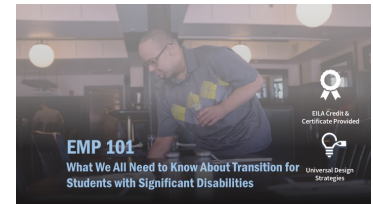


### **Employment 101: What We All Need to Know About Transition for Students with Significant Disabilities**

EMP 102 describes the strongest, evidence-based strategies to help youth with intellectual & developmental disabilities prepare for post-school competitive employment.

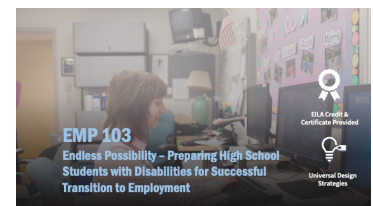

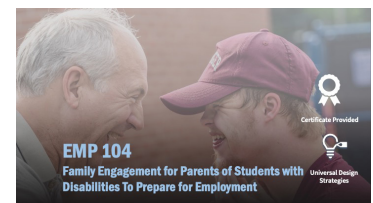
